



Welcome to Peaceful Pines in Prescott Arizona! We are excited to have you as our guests!

Directions to Peaceful Pines at 1360 Copper Canyon Dr

Montezuma south from downtown to Copper Basin
Turn right on Copper Basin (follow approx 2 miles)
Turn left on Copper Canyon
Make 2 rights to stay on Copper Canyon
Turn left into our gravel driveway - look for our address
sign, the gravel is not too long and driveway is paved.

Parking: You may park in the garage, on the driveway or in the dirt or gravel just off the driveway. Please do not park at the neighbors 3 car garage near the top of our driveway.

Self Check-in with your code at the front door


Enter the home for the first time by the front door. Once you have the garage door opener you can enter there if you wish.

Packing & Planning:

We provide all the bedding and bath linens, cooking utensils, pots and pans, spices and plenty of dishes so you can cook at the home if you wish! There are many great restaurants in the area. A Keurig coffee maker and coffee will be provided but you are also welcome to bring your favorite pods along.

There is a Safeway grocery store at the corner of White Spar and Copper Basin. There is also a Sprouts farmers market in downtown Prescott on Sheldon and Montezuma.

There are many hiking trails in Prescott so you may want to pack your hiking shoes!

Feel free to log in to your favorite streaming service on any of the 3 tv's provided.

The tv in the living room has a sound bar and that will need to be turned on each time.

Remotes are located in the living room and in both bedrooms.

Please feel free to use the front patio or back deck to enjoy the property. The fire pit is also on our property and can be used when the wild fire threat is low. Please do not leave fires unattended and be sure to thoroughly extinguish them when finished. There are plastic cups and dishes to use when outside.

The trash can is located in the garage.

Trash is picked up on Friday mornings. The can will need to be pulled to the top of the drive way before 8am on Friday morning. The can should not be put out the night before due to animals in the area. Be sure to use the bear strap to prevent javelinas or other wildlife from strewing the contents about the property.

Please do be respectful of our neighbors when enjoying the outdoors. Also, it is best for our animal neighbors that they not become accustomed to being fed so please do not feed the deer, javelina, birds, cats or any other creatures that may come to visit.

CHECK IN TIME 3:00 PM

- 1. The code to the front door will be the last 4 digits of the phone number used to make the reservation.
- 2. The front door code will work from check in time to check out time on the day of departure.
- 3. There are keys in the tray on the entertainment center in the living room
- 4. The home has been professionally cleaned and sanitized prior to your stay.
- 5. We have endeavored to provide all the items you need during your stay but if there is anything else you need let us know.

CHECK OUT TIME 11:00 AM

We have the home professionally cleaned so you do not need to do much other than pack up whatever you brought with you.

- 1. Please leave all items in the places where you found them when you arrived.
- 2. Log out of your streaming service on all tv's.
- 3. Discard all perishable food from your stay and put the trash in the trash can in the garage.
- 4. It does help if the dishes are loaded into the dishwasher.
- 5. Leave the bedding on the beds.
- 6. Make sure all windows and doors are secured and all appliances, the fireplace, heaters and/or fans are turned off.
- 7. Please do not leave bed linens combined with wet or damp towels.
- 8. Please leave the garage door opener and keys in the tray on the entertainment center in the living room.
- 9. In order to prepare for our next reservation our cleaning crew needs to start promptly at 11AM therefore any delayed departures will be billed to the guest at \$100 per hour.




